Extra tool bars appear on your browser.

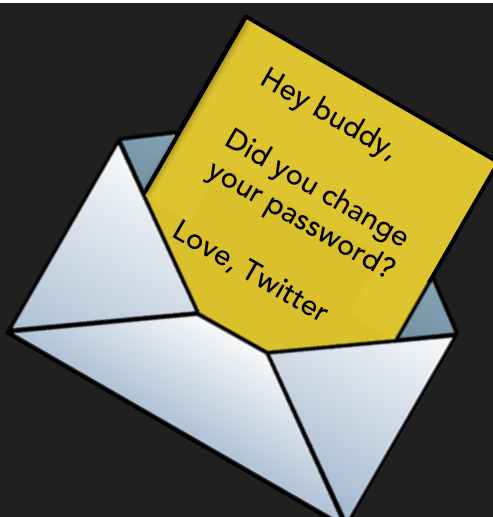
Your browser history is inaccurate.

## YOU'LL RECEIVE EMAILS FROM...

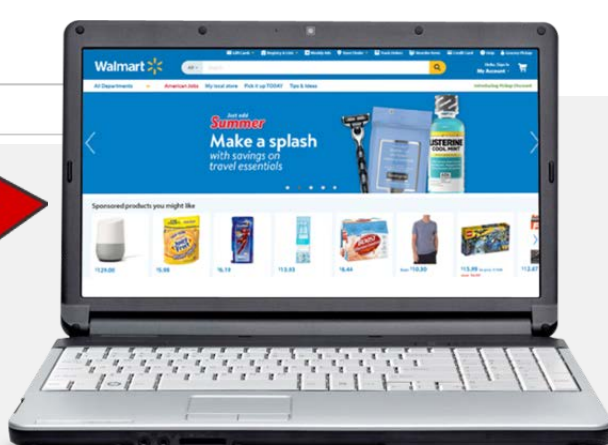
Social media and cloud-based sites about failed login attempts or password changes you didn't make.
